


Within the car park of Cockhedge Shopping Centre sits an unused car park kiosk, which traditionally served as a place for people to pay for their parking.


With the advent of modern parking machines, the kiosk slowly fell out of use and now sits abandoned and unloved.






We invite the community to share their ideas and proposals for how this space can be utilised, and make Cockhedge an even more dynamic place to visit.
